


LOFOTEN AND THE MIDNIGHT SUN

Exploring the Lofoten islands by sailboat is without any doubt an unique experience! The dramatic views, especially during twilight hours is just amazing. Mountains rise up straight out of the ocean. Land and ocean are constantly taking over in the views. The stretch of islands have been shaped over thousands of years by wind, waves and ice.

The start and finish location of this expedition is Moskenes. Along our voyage we will go through some well known fjords, islands and cities. The route is made to be weatherproof, flexible and to adapt to all sorts of level of fitness while maintaining and guarantee a maximum usage of our time.

The perfect summer season to travel the Lofoten is from June until the end of August. We will deal with the most comfortable temperatures of the year: between 12 and 26 degrees Celsius. During this time of the year, the sun is hardly dropping beneath the horizon. This means we will have countless possibilities to plan our day activities. Overall the weather is also the most forgiving during these months. Although, in Norway the weather can always change from one moment to the next. We as crew of the Moondance need to be able to respond to the unexpected changes we see often in those areas.



DAY TO DAY SCHEDULE

Day 1 (Sunday): Arrival

After arriving at the Airport of Bodø, you will have to transfer to Moskenes by ferry. This will take a little over three hours. In the Moskenes Harbour the Moondance awaits you and you will meet the Sailing Crew in the afternoon. After unpacking and settling in on the boat, we will discuss the plan and your expectations for the next seven days. We will set sail after a comfy nights rest.







Day 2-6 (Monday to Friday): Sailing and Exploration

The route we will sail will be a continuum breathtaking highlights as we will be experiencing the Lofoten mountains from the best point of view, that is from the water. Traveling by sailboat brings the possibility of discovering the most remote and unknown fjords and islands. Our daily program starts with a hearty breakfast in the morning and you will be able to prepare a take away lunch. During the day we make one or two stops where we undertake activities as hiking, climbing, fishing, swimming and exploring cultural sites. Before dinner we will set sail again and anchor in sight of next day's adventure. We gladly enjoy our well deserved Moondance beer and be surprised by the catch of the day!





Day 7: Departure (Saturday)

After breakfast, it's time to hug it out with everybody and commemorate all the great memories made and the adventures lived during the tour. We will give you a ride to the ferry terminal and wave goodbye.



MOONDANCE

Our expedition boat Moondance is a custom built 56ft aluminium Koopmans. Designed by Dick Koopmans jr. and build to withstand arctic conditions with comfort.

Moondance is a real sailing boat, one of the things we like so much about her. The cockpit is big (we even have a real rudder) and there is a lot of space outside when staying on deck. Inside you will find a central lounge, in the front you will find the guests sleeping area and the crew sleeps in the back. Moondance offers berths for a total of 6 guests, 2 crew members and 1 guide. There is sufficient heating, a hot shower, a toilet, equipment storage and much more.



FAQ

Life on board of the Moondance, what's it like?

Living on a sailing vessel differs from any other type of holiday. Sailing itself brings uncertainties and asks for a flexible attitude towards the schedule, people and your expectations. What fitness and is required for this trip?

On top of that, every activity can be adapted for both beginners and more experienced adventurers alike. When it comes to the hikes, if you're at least decently fit, you're good to go. Every location will have different possibilities for activities and they are all optional. So if you prefer to relax on the boat and enjoy the stunning views that is perfectly fine.


What should I bring?
